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Hanhaga is a 3 and half-week long programme that takes place in Upstate New York at Camp Tel Yehudah (TY). Camp TY is the senior leadership camp of Young Judaea, FZY's sister movement in the USA and those participating in Hanhaga will have the opportunity to experience life as a camper on a typical American Summer Camp.

The Hanhaga programme will focus on global activism and will most likely include a trip to Washington D.C. and New York City, where campers will have informative sessions at places such as the State Department, United Nations, American Jewish Congress and other centres of international and Jewish activism.

Hanhaga participants will also be able to take advantage of the incredible facilities available: including a ropes course, a brand new water sports centre, climbing walls, tennis courts, volleyball nets, football pitches, performing arts facilities and experts to help in every field. All participants will be fully registered campers at Tel Yehudah and benefit from all the facilities and staffing afforded to any participant.

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Please note that in previous years our programmes have filled up remarkably quickly so we cannot guarantee that your child will receive a place. FZY reserves the right to reject any application. Non-successful applicants will have their deposits returned to them.

We would not normally consider any application that is not for the full term of the programme but if there are any extenuating circumstances as to why your child cannot stay the full three and a half weeks please put this in writing together with the application form.

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Travel: The price of Hanhaga includes the cost of return transport from departure points designated by FZY. Arrangements will be made for those who don't live near those places.

Cancellation: Cancellations made before 26th March 2010 will be returned minus a £75 administration fee. This date is the final date of cancellation, and no monies will be returned after this date. Applicants are strongly advised to make their own insurance arrangements to cover the loss of deposit and/or full payment due to unavoidable cancellations. Applicants are also advised to arrange **medical insurance** and **personal insurance for their child's belongings**.

I understand that acceptance on the programme will be determined by a school reference and medical application and review of behaviour and participation on previous FZY programmes. The information received will be kept confidential and no candidate will be eliminated from participation solely on the basis of a school reference. If my child's application is not accepted my deposit will be returned in full.

I further understand that should my child/ward be unruly or breach discipline rules then he/she will be returned to Britain at my expense.
