Hanhaga is FZY's new American camp experience for 17 year olds (year 12). FZY is joining with our American sister movement, Young Judaea to provide an innovative and exciting programme for those chanichim (participants) looking for a summer that is different from anything that they have ever experienced before.

Chanichim on **Hanhaga** will be joining the **Sayeret Olami** programme and be part of the American Camp experience. They will be based at Young Judaea's senior leadership camp Tel Yehudah (TY) in upstate New York. TY hosts 500 13-18 year old campers in its incredible 150 acre fully equipped site.

Hanhaga is an international leadership and activism programme. Chanichim will be joined by Americans and Israelis and other teenagers from around the world in learning leadership skills, social and political activism and running activities for campers at Tel Yehudah.

Chanichim will:

- Visit leaders and organisations at the centre of global activism and policy in Washington DC and New York City
- Meet with and learn from leaders from the Jewish and social activist world
- Gain practical skills to affect change in their community and the world
- Develop a deepened knowledge of and affect an issue of their choice
- Participate in a "Tikun Team" that will focus their skills on affecting change around a specific issue today
- Develop and sharpen their activist skills through specialised workshops
- Develop a project to be implemented globally after camp with other Sayeret Olami grads
- Receive a certificate of Completion of the Sayeret Olami Leadership and Activism Institute

Chanichim will travel to Washington DC to see the Capitol Building and the White House, and visit the United Nations in New York City. Of course there will also be time for the Empire State building and the obligatory shopping!

But **Hanhaga** will not only be about leadership and activism. Just as important is the TY experience and the incredible facilities that are available to Hanhaga chanichim: A ropes course, a brand new water sports centre, climbing walls, sports facilities - tennis courts, volleyball and football pitches. All of this is in addition to the arts, music and drama experts and equipment. With Tel Yehudah located on the banks of the river, rafting is also part of the Hanhaga programme.

Hanhaga will provide chanichim with a chance to build their leadership skills, meet young Jews from the UK, US and Israel and empower and inspire them to change the world!

All participants will be fully registered campers at Tel Yehudah and benefit from all the facilities, staffing and insurance afforded to any American participant.
