WILL I BE SPLIT UP FROM MY FRIENDS?

No!

When applicants fill out the online application form, they are invited to submit the names of up to three friends that they would like to be in the same group as. We work hard to ensure that friends are not split up, and we guarantee that participants will be placed with at least one of their named friends (and often more!).

WHAT IS THE ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD LIKE?

Like most Israel Tours, FZY groups stay in lots of different types of overnight accommodation, including Kibbutzim, youth villages, and campsites. You can expect that the vast majority of nights will be spent in youth hostels; these are basic but clean and often quite lovely. Rooms typically sleep around four participants, normally with en-suite bathrooms and showers.

Breakfast and dinner are often served buffet-style in hostels. Because participants spend each day out and about, lunch varies between sandwiches, packed lunches, and hot lunch deliveries (like school meals!). All of the food we provide is certified Kosher and the programme caters for a wide range of allergies and dietary requirements.

Sometimes, if groups are spending a lunchtime in a marketplace or an evening in a shopping mall, participants receive the cash-equivalent of a meal so that they can choose their own food.

ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS & DEADLINES

It is quick and simple to register. The account and Primary Email Address should both be in the name of the parent or guardian whom you wish to receive the majority of Israel Tour communications.

Online application process and deadlines:

Applications will open at 9:00am on Monday 12th February 2024. Places are subject to availability and require a deposit of £500.

Price: £4,489

- The Deadline for the initial application is Monday 4th March 2024.
- All full application and medical forms need to be received and completed by Monday 18th March 2024.
- If you withdraw from the programme prior to March 18th, you are entitled to a full refund of the deposit.
- After March 18th, if you choose to cancel, you would be subject to the normal cancellation policy and you would lose your deposit.
- The full balance payment must be made no later than 1st MAY 2024.

INSURANCE

- As part of the Israel Tour cost, basic medical, travel and baggage insurance are included. Policy details are available on request.
- Pre-existing health conditions and non-emergency psychiatric and dental treatment are not included in the policy.
- To ensure participant are comprehensively insured, families should consider taking out their own personal insurance policy.
- The travel insurance policy covers you for cancellation, curtailment, and disruption in a number of scenarios, as well as covering lost, delayed or damaged luggage.
- Despite this cover, we encourage all participants not to bring expensive or valuable items with them on Israel Tour to avoid unnecessary upset.
- The policy does cover you during times of war, and whilst FCDO guidance is against travel to Israel, however it does not cover claims brought about as a direct result of war.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

UJIA and FZY who run Israel tour, are committed to financial inclusion to ensure that all young people in the British Jewish community can participate in the programme. Families unable to meet the full cost of the programme can apply for means-tested financial assistance provided by the UJIA. FZY and the Friends of FZY.

The UJIA Bursary Fund Committee guarantees complete confidentiality throughout the process and the identities of the recipients of bursaries remain anonymous. More details can be found online.

Please note that at any time up until departure, you may incur the price of an additional fuel surcharge and airport tax by the airline. FZY will have to pass any increased charges on to participants and their families, as per our terms and conditions.

SECURITY MEASURES

At FZY, the safety and security of our participants and staff are our utmost priorities. We will not take any risks that could put anyone on our programme in harm's way. Therefore, due to the recent outbreak of war in the region, FZY, UJIA, and our tour providers, Tlalim, will continuously monitor the developing situation. Tlalim is guided by the Cheder Matzav (Security Service) in Israel on appropriate actions and precautions to take or any necessary alterations. If circumstances worsen or persist, alternative arrangements may be made, and all our participants will be well-informed and regularly updated. For now, the lead-up to the programme will continue as usual.

A security guard will accompany all groups when advised by our security advisors to do so and this year we have anticipated there may be the need for an armed guard at all times.
